White or pale blue polo shirt
School sweatshirt (available in school office)
Black, navy or grey school skirt or trousers
Plain dark or white socks or tights
Black or navy shoes (no trainers)

Summer Uniform

White or pale blue polo shirt
Black, navy or grey school skirt, shorts or trousers
Plain blue/white gingham school dress
Plain dark or white socks
Lightweight shoes or sandals (but not open toed)

Please note that jeans, leggings, tracksuits and trainers are not permissible.

High heeled shoes are also unsuitable.
