Oak Newsletter Spring 2024


This Spring Term in Oak is very busy with our learning in school and several out of school activities and events including our London Residential which has had an amazing uptake. We are all very excited!


This term's focus in Writing will be: script-writing, a narrative based in another culture, biography and poetry with a focus on word-play. Our class reading books are: The Boy in the Tower, an annotated

version of Shakespeare's
Midsummer Night's Dream and
biographies about artists,
scientists, athletes and activists
with disabilities called, I am not a
Label. In Geography our focus is 4
and 6 figure grid references. In
History we are comparing the
African Kingdom of Benin with
Britain: 900 to 1300 AD. In
science we will focus on forces and
space and earth. In Art and DT
we're looking at textiles and
collage, 3-D and Food and
Nutrition. In Music we will learn

songs linked to seasons and festivals and also a range of pop songs which we will sing and accompany using a tuned instruments and musical score. In RE we will look at how belief in God or Allah has impacted music and art through history. PE will be a range of gymnastics and netball and basketball skills, team work and in-class competitions. In Computing we will look at programming and data and information.

Learning at Home / Additional Tuition

I will also send home online links to revision websites which children should be encouraged to have a go at throughout the weeks. Over the half term and Easter break there will also be worksheet supplied for children to work through. Please support them to work through their tasks and return them to school after their break.

Please ensure your child comes to school in school uniform unless otherwise advised. The weather is changeable and wet so make sure they have appropriate clothing and school shoes (not trainers, not heels) to keep them safe, warm and dry. This term, children will have Woodland Learning on Wednesday morning. (Year 5 from next week, for 5 weeks, Year 6 from the week beginning 12/2 until the end of the term.) They will need to come to in wearing appropriate clothes and bring school uniform to change into. On Friday, PE as usual. Children come in PE kit: black or blue leggings, jog bottoms or shorts (no logo), a plain white, blue or school T-shirt, school sweatshirt or a plain blue one and trainers. A reminder that nail varnish and jewellery (earrings on posts excepted) should not be worn at school and that long hair must be pulled away from faces. Children are allow their own bottles of squash, water or juice at lunchtime. Water bottles are available throughout the day.
