Heart Boy and Rooftoppers and the picture book, How to Live Forever. In Geography our focus is on physical geography: volcanos, earthquakes and mountains. In History we are looking in-depth at WWII's Battle of Britain. In Science our topic is physics-based with the study of Electricity and our biology topic is Animals including Humans. In Art children are learning to draw in detail using scale and proportion and still life painting combined with collage. In DT, children will study and food from other cultures. In Music we will learn about interrelated dimensions of music through song, instruments and improvising - pop music and jazz. In RE we will discuss the Big Questions: Is believing in God reasonable AND How has a belief in God or Allah impacted on music and art through history? In Computing we will explore how data is transferred over the internet.

Learning at Home

During the week, children need a reading book in school, which they will take home at the weekend and be expected to read aloud from, to an adult. (Don't forget to sign and date the reading record please⁽³⁾.) This book will be chosen at school though children can bring their own if it is appropriate to their reading level

Every child can log onto TT Rock Stars at home to practise times tables. Please encourage them to practise regularly. The better they are at quickly solving tables questions, the more confident they will be in all of their maths lessons and assessments.

(Starting next term, Year 6 children will begin to bring home revision work for SATs practise.)

Please ensure your child comes to school in school uniform unless otherwise advised. The weather will become changeable and wet so make sure they have appropriate clothing and school shoes (not trainers, not heels) to keep them safe, warm and dry. This term, Y6 will have Woodland Learning on Wednesday afternoon. (Year 5 will have Woodland Learning in the new year for a term.) They will need to come in wearing appropriate clothes and bring school uniform to change into. On Friday, PE. This includes the village 1.4 mile run. Children come in PE kit: black or blue leggings, jog bottoms or shorts (no logo), a plain white, blue or school T-shirt, school sweatshirt or a plain blue one and trainers. A reminder that nail varnish and jewellery (earrings on posts excepted) should not be worn at school and that long hair must be pulled away from faces. Children are allowed their own bottles of squash, water or juice at lunchtime. Water bottles can be brought from home for use through the day (please make sure these are filled with water).
