This week in class...

Ash Class - This week in Ash class we have been reading, 'What Makes Me Me?' We have talked about how we are all unique and have shared what is special about ourselves as well as celebrating differences. We have also talked about the feelings and emotions that the main character felt throughout the story and identified times when we have felt the same. We have painted some amazing self portraits to decorate our classroom and thought about language to describe ourselves and each other. We have also started our Rea Write Inc. phonics lessons. In maths, we have been looking at and making patterns.

Elm Class - This week Elm Class created a whole class collage based on the importance of light to Christians. We used different media to represent light in different ways. We have also been thinking about writing in the third person, and writing in the past tense. In PE we played team games to develop our listening and communication skills. We have also been developing our observation skills. We used magnifying glasses to observe plants in our local area, carefully drawing and labelled all the things we noticed. We discussed how different this investigation would be in the winter months where many children drew upon previous learning to think about deciduous and evergreen trees.

Beech Class - In Beech class this week we have written our rules for staying safe online and created slogans to help us remember to use them. In science we carried out an investigation about invertebrates. We set pitfall traps to collect creatures in the woodland learning area. Although it was only partially successful we did manage to catch a worm and a snail. We classified these as Annelids and Molluscs.

Oak Class - This week in Oak we have been doing assessments in maths, reading, grammar and spelling. It has been tough but everyone persevered and did really well! We also began our science top, which is Humans and other animals and found out that humans are made up of 60% H2O or water. We have also started a new writing topic - speeches (discursive writing) and are looking forward to getting stuck into a subject that we feel passionate about.
